

Highlight of the Seminar on “Spectroscopy & Imaging in a Day”

(held at IIT Tirupati on Feb. 01, 2020)

A one-day seminar on spectroscopy and imaging technologies was hosted by IIT Tirupati on February 1, 2020 (Saturday) and has been jointly organized by the Department of Chemistry and PerkinElmer India Pvt. Ltd. The main aim was to discuss the advances in spectroscopy and imaging technologies and their applications to diverse field of chemical sciences, physics, biological sciences, pharmaceuticals and engineering.
